Vineyards

3ha of leased vineyard situated on the limestone plateau of Sainte-Colombe. Vineyards managed as organic since 2012 and addition of biodynamic mixtures since 2019.

Harvest

By hand, on the 12th and 13th September.

Vinification method

Transfer of whole grapes by gravity into cement vats. Fermentation conducted at low temperature (max 25°C). End of fermentation on juice.

Ageing

Ageing on lees in stainless steel vats for 3 months. No fining.



5100 bottles on the 3rd February 2020.
